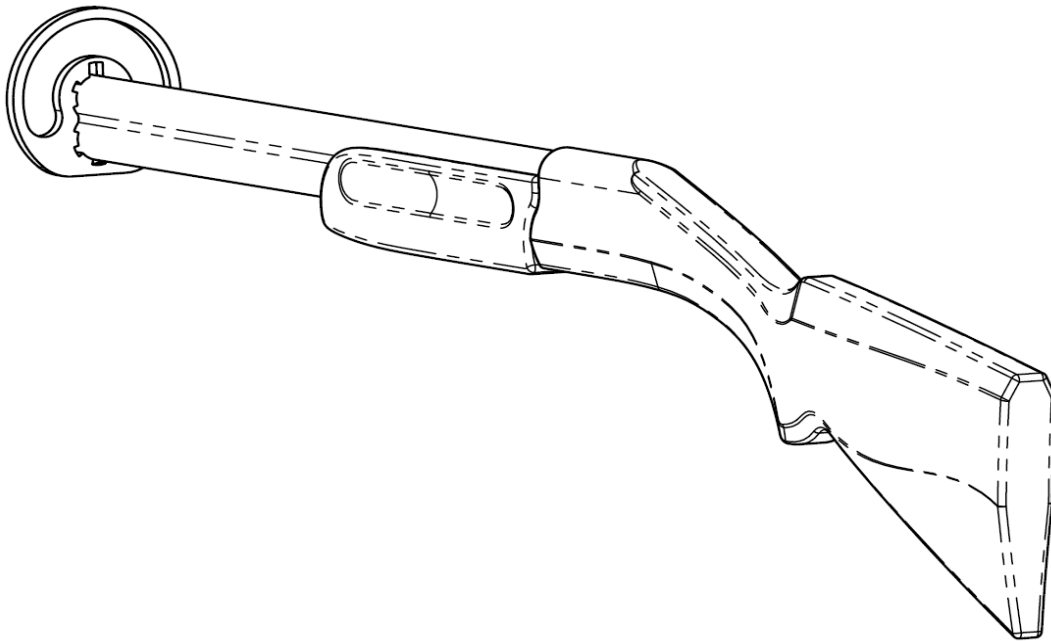


Product description, NitoAim shotgun sight

The NitoAim shotgun sight has been designed to help shooters focus better on a moving target. The sight may of course also be used for stationary targets, but it comes into its own with moving targets, such as clay-pigeon and bird shooting.

The sight has been specially designed to capture a target up to 30 metres away, moving at a speed equivalent to a clay pigeon or a migrating duck. The sight enables shooters to focus clearly and see whether or not they have the right lead or aim-off on the moving target.



The sight, which is a registered design in the EU, is available in various sizes to suit different barrel diameters on different types of shotgun. For single-barrel weapons, sights are available for barrel diameters between 16 mm and 26 mm. For over-and-under shotguns, sights are available for diameters between 18 mm and 26 mm.

The sight is made from a polythene plastic that is both heat and cold resistant, as well as being slightly elastic.

What size should I choose for my shotgun?

Please make sure that your weapon is not loaded before you carry out the following steps.

To select the right size of sight, you need to know the exterior diameter of your shotgun barrel. Measure the barrel using slide callipers.



All NitoAim sights carry a number, so if for example the exterior diameter of your barrel is 22 mm, you need a sight numbered 22. You can choose different diameter sizes in our web shop.

The sight is fitted to the barrel as shown below. Position the shotgun butt down.



Insert the front-sight bead into the top of the sight's attachment hole, as shown below.



Then press the bottom of the sight over the lower part of the muzzle.



This is what the sight looks like when fitted to the shotgun barrel.



Store the sight in its box when not in use. Remove the sight by performing the above steps in reverse order. It only takes a few seconds to fit and remove the sight.
